**Under this agreement for 2018
Cooran State School will receive**

\$75,160*

This funding will be used to

- Improve student reading comprehension, increase number of students achieving PAT-R Stanine 5 and above from 60% to 75%
- Lift the performance of top students, increase student achievement in Upper 2 Bands (U2B) on NAPLAN in Years 3 and Year 5. Target: Minimum 50% on all Domains.
- Increase and embed staff opportunities for professional development surrounding classroom pedagogy, moderation and data analysis.

Our initiatives include

- Continued development and implementation of the Daily Rapid Reading support program targeting student needs.
- Implement a Data Literacy professional development program to assist teacher knowledge in effectively using data to inform targeted teaching.
- Implement a formalised student extension program to assist in continued numeracy and literacy development of high achieving students.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Provide TRS to enable teachers and leaders to engage in collaborative data inquiry, professional development and classroom visits. (TRS x 7 staff x 4 Terms = \$12 000)
- Develop, resource and implement a professional development and coaching program to support teachers in data gathering, collation, analysis and usage in planning for targeted teaching. (TRS x 7 Staff Days x 4 Terms = \$12 000)
- Increase teacher aide hours to support reading interventions and extension programs (\$30 000)
- Provide targeted resources to support the implementation of extension programs and to meet U2B targets set in Reading. (\$25 036)
